

## 2.2 Occupational Health and Safety (OH &S) Policy

Unidata operates and maintains a Management System which meets the requirements of AS/NZS 4801:2001, legislation, regulations and subscribed codes of practice.

We regard health and safety as a core value.

Unidata policy is to make the Unidata operations both in factory and in field to be safe for staff, contractors, visitors and the general public

Unidata shall promote a culture of safety and zero harm on an ongoing and continuous basis.

We shall,

- comply with all OH&S legislation and regulations
  
- ensure the safety of all Unidata staff, contractors, sub-contractors and the general public visiting the Unidata premises
  
- encourage every staff member to bring to the elected Occupational Health and Safety Representative any possible safety risk, regardless of how small.
  
- promote a culture of zero harm in every aspect of our operations by encouraging all staff to make a note of and report any potential OH&S risk.
  
- make OH&S an agenda item in all staff meetings
  
- ensure appropriate staff are trained in First Aid to assist in any incident
  
- provide the necessary resources, training and education to enable staff to understand and safely perform their duties. promote a management culture to immediately act upon any identified OH&S risks.
  
- work towards achieving and maintaining certification for AS / NZS 4801 compliant safety management systems as a component of our existing ISO 9001 Quality System
  
- encourage all personnel to offer suggestions for improvement for all to OH&S matters at staff meetings.
